Appliances: Refrigerators, ranges, washers, dryers and freezers.



Furniture: Couches, dining sets, dressers, bookshelves, end tables, outdoor furniture.



Building materials: Lumber, plywood, trim, block, fencing, insulation (preferably new or excellent condition).



Home décor: Picture frames, dishes, art, artificial plants.



Cabinets: Kitchen and bathroom. Must have drawers and doors attached. Solid wood or pressed board.



Lighting: Chandeliers, track lighting, desk lamp, floor lamps (torchieres excluded).



Hardware: Hinges, doorknobs, nails, fasteners, electrical, cabinet pulls.



Plumbing: Kitchen, bath, and utility sinks. Toilets, low flow 1.6 gallon flush or less. Bathtubs, shower enclosures, faucets.



Flooring: Ceramic, vinyl, porcelain, laminate or wood. New only.



Windows and Doors: Double pane or impact windows only. Interior and exterior doors.

Donations should be in working order and have no missing hardware or broken parts; deep scratches, chips or cracks; fabric with stains, tears or strong odors; pet hair or stains; or other major damage. Donation criteria may change over time, so please contact the store for more details.

The store is happy to provide a donation receipt for tax purposes.

Unacceptable items

For recycling options, check with your municipality or visit Earth911.com.

Toilets larger than 1.6 gallons

Unframed glass or mirrors

Plumbing fixtures that are not EPA compliant

Fluorescent, commercial or mercury lighting

Clothing

Used mattresses and box springs

Fire-rated doors (asbestos exposure)

Ammunition/weapons

Cabinets with mold or mildew damage

Used water heaters, furnaces and heat pumps

Used wall to wall carpeting

Tube TVs, TVs older than 5 years
